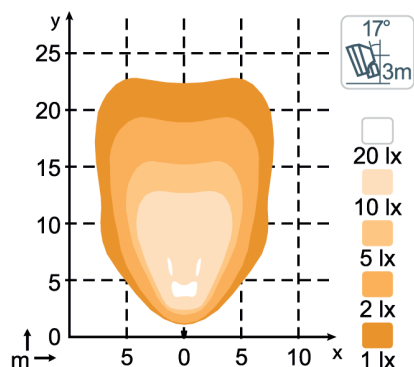

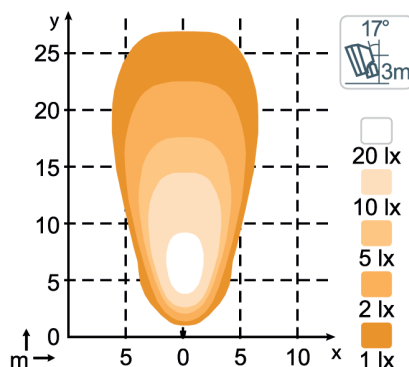

Flood - T988-203B 1 800 Lumens

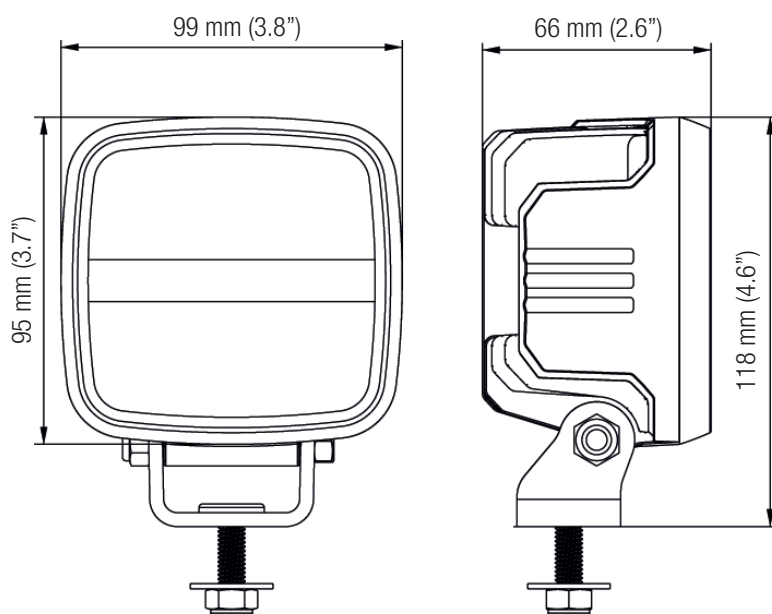
